PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Hertfordshire County Council (Wareside 4) Diversion Order 2024

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the bridleway described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr Jonathan Morgan Davies and Mrs Lisa Francesca Davies have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

East Herts District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:


- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Wareside and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this order ("The Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up on the date on which the authority certifies that the public bridleway described in paragraph 2 below is in fit condition for use by the public such date not being earlier than 60 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall at the end of 60 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public bridleway over the land situate at Wareside described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.
- 3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Wareside Bridleway 4 commencing at TL 3869 1546 (Point A on the Order Plan) and then running in a south-easterly direction for approximately 35 metres to TL 3872 1545 (Point B on the Order Plan).

PART 2 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A bridleway commencing at a junction with Wareside Bridleway 4 at TL 3869 1546 (Point A on the Order Plan) and heading in a generally southerly direction for approximately 33 metres to join Wareside Restricted Byway 24 at TL 3869 1543 (Point C on the Order Plan).

Width: 4 metres.
